**Schedule:** Courses are offered fall through spring each year and are rotated at different locations throughout the archdiocese.

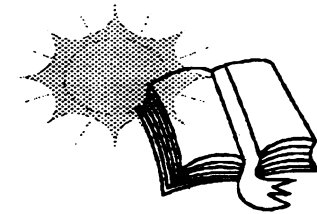
**Access:** Some course locations are wheelchair accessible. Please call for details.

This course looks at the experience of the Church alive and in communion with God through the witness of the Sacred Scriptures and the teaching of the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, Part 4, on prayer. We will have the opportunity to be that praying Church as a part of this course.

**Presenter: Fr. John Gordon** is a popular conference speaker, retreat director, and maintains an active ministry of spiritual direction. After serving in a variety of assignments in both school and parish, he is currently the Acting Vicar for Pastoral Life for the Archdiocese of Newark.

#### DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO ST. BARTHOLOMEW, SCOTCH PLAINS 2032 Westfield Avenue Scotch Plains, NJ 07076

#### From the Garden State Parkway Southbound

Take exit 140A to merge onto US-22 West toward NJ-82 E/Elizabeth/Somerville. Stay on US-22 West for about 7 miles. (Go through Union and Mountainside to Scotch Plains on US-22. Do not take the "Mountain Avenue to Sheffield Street" exit. That is only half way there.) After 7 miles take "jug handle" ramp to the right for "Mountain Avenue/Scotch Plains." After crossing US-22 make a right onto Mountain Avenue. After about 8/10 mile turn left at light onto Westfield Road. Go 5 blocks, counting on your right to the light and turn right onto Westfield Avenue. Continue with **Westfield Avenue** below.

#### From the Garden State Parkway Northbound


Take exit 135 toward Clark/Westfield. Follow signs to left turn onto "Central Avenue, Westfield/Garwood". After about 2.7 miles turn left onto North Ave W. After about 1.6 mi turn right onto Westfield Road. After about 1 mile turn left onto Westfield Ave. Continue with **Westfield Avenue** below.

#### Westfield Avenue

Keep an eye out to the left. About 2/10 mile down the road you will come to the driveway on the left onto the church property. This will be the first intersection on the left after making the turn from Westfield Avenue. Look for the church sign and bell tower since the church is set far back from the road and might not be immediately visible. (On the right you will pass Ridgeview Avenue and Cook Avenue. Then the church driveway on the left. If you pass Montague Avenue or Park Avenue you have gone too far.)

(See directions "At the Church" at the top of the next column for parking and entry information.)

**At the church:** Drive all the way around to park in the back of the church/school building. After parking come around on **the right side** of the church (if you are facing the building **from the back**) to find the side door nearest the rectory. This brings you to the gym.

 **Access:** The gym at St. Bartholomew is accessible to wheelchairs. Please call Connie Boruch at the Religious Education Office (908-322-2359) in advance for details and to make arrangements to use the elevator.
